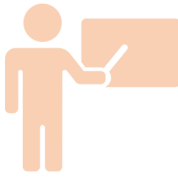
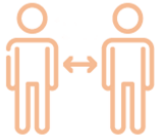


TANGANYIKA EXPEDITIONS

HEALTH PROTOCOL AS OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2020.



All employees (driver-guides & lodge staff) are trained and will adhere to COVID-19 prevention and control measures.



All employees (driver-guides & lodge staff) will maintain physical distance when interacting with our guests.



Each one of our properties will appoint a COVID-19 liaison officer who will be the point of contact for both guests and staff in case questions arise.



Upon arrival at JRO airport & upon check-in at camps/lodges, our staff (driver-guides & lodge staff) will have masks available in case guests require for these to be worn by our staff (guests will have to bring their own masks if they wish to wear those at some point during their safari).



Upon check-in, guests will also be reminded about preventive and protective practices against COVID-19.



All contact surfaces (accommodations & safari vehicles) will be cleaned and sanitized with approved disinfectants on a regular basis.



Hand washing facilities as well as Hydro-alcoholic gel will be available at all properties for both guests and staff.



Occupation in dining areas will be limited to comply with social distancing and plate service will replace buffet style meals whenever possible.
